## The Winchester Spring Qualifier

### Promoters Conditions

This is a **licensed level 1 Competition** – Licence Number 1SE220339 - promoted by Winchester City Penguins Swimming Club, which is affiliated to the Swim England South East Region. The competition is held under Swim England Laws and Technical Rules of Racing.

The aims of the meet are for swimmers to attempt to gain qualification times for Regional and National Meets.

### Facilities

Long course 50m 8 lane pool with anti-wave ropes.

Backstroke ledges, starting strobe, electronic Swiss timing.

(Swimmers requiring the strobe are requested to declare this with their entry).

20m warm down pool once each session has started (no diving allowed in this pool; at busy times numbers in this pool may be limited).

### Entries

Ages as at midnight on 31st December 2022.

All swimmers must be aged 10 years or over at 31st December 2022 and be registered with Swim England as competitive swimmers with Club Compete (formerly level 2) Membership. Only swimmers aged 11 years and over may enter the 400m Individual Medley and 800m / 1500m Freestyle events.

Lower limit **long course** qualifying times apply. Entry times must be equal to or faster than these and have been achieved at a Licensed Meet since 1st January 2021. Short course time conversions may be used. Random checks on entry times will be made. If swimmers are found to have entered the meet with any false times, they will be disqualified from all events that they have entered and their entry fees will be forfeited.

Multi-disability qualifying times are available on request.

Entry fees will be £9 per event, except 800/1500m events which will be £15. Individual entries not submitted as part of a club electronic file will incur an additional £10 admin fee per swimmer. PLEASE DO NOT send payment until entries are confirmed.

**The opening date for entries is Tuesday 1st February and the closing date is Monday 21st February at midnight.** If the meet is under-subscribed late entries may be accepted.

All club entries should be submitted electronically using Hytek. The entry file, the Hytek summary entry report and the club summary sheet should be emailed together by the closing date to [winchestermeets@wcpssc.org.uk](mailto:winchestermeets@wcpssc.org.uk).



In the event the meet is over-subscribed, subject to a minimum of three swimmers being retained in each age group where entries permit, the Promoter shall remove proportionate numbers of the slowest swimmers from each age group per event until the accepted swims fit within the available time.

The 800m and 1500m Freestyle events will be swum as mixed gender, combined age groups and seeded on entry times.

Notification of acceptance/rejection of entries will be made electronically to each club, along with an invoice for payment. Payment must then be made within 5 working days, or all entries from that club risk being rejected.

Swimmers / clubs are responsible for checking their entry confirmation and any errors found must be notified no later than three days after entry confirmation is published. After this time, it may not be possible to make any amendments, unless the error has been made by Winchester City Penguins SC.

Swimmers will be distributed in heats from the submitted entry times. Improved times will not be accepted after the entries have been received. There will be no finals and all events will be swum on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis.

### **Poolside passes**

All swimmers must be accompanied on poolside at all times by a Coach or Team Manager registered with Swim England and with a current DBS check. Poolside passes (maximum 4 per club) are £30 per whole / part of the meet to include heat sheets, results (one set per club), a buffet meal and refreshments. Where clubs wish to bring a large team, and in order to comply with the Swim England supervision guidelines, require additional coaches to attend the meet, the Meet organiser should be contacted regarding additional coaches passes.

### **Covid-19**

The meet will be run in accordance with Government and Swim England guidelines in place at the time of the meet.

At the time of license application, we are under plan B restrictions, which do not impact sports events significantly. However, the operator is likely to insist on there being no spectators. If guidelines change between the publication of these conditions and the dates of the meet then the Meet conditions may need to be amended. Amendments could include cancellation, mask wearing, reduced swims, and food availability.

To continue with limiting the spread of this virus we ask swimmers, coaches, helpers and



spectators that have Covid symptoms not to arrive at the pool and to continue following Government guidance. People who have been advised to isolate due to contact with a Covid-19 case should also not attend.

## **Withdrawals**

There will be no sign in for this meet. Team managers will be given sheets to record withdrawals on the day. Withdrawals must be made by the time the warm up for each session commences. Withdrawals may also be emailed ahead of the meet to [winchestermeets@wcpssc.org.uk](mailto:winchestermeets@wcpssc.org.uk) no later than 3pm on Friday March 25th.

## **Officials**

All clubs submitting entries are requested to assist in the running of the meet by supplying details of any licensed officials who are willing to assist. Clubs with an entry over 8 swimmers are requested to provide at least 1 official per session. Drinks will be available for all officials and food will be provided for those officials who volunteer to work consecutive sessions. For those volunteering in every session each day expenses can be offered to a maximum of £40 or claimed at 40p per mile, whichever is less.

## **Awards**

Awards will be made in the following age groups: 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17/over. Medals will be awarded for the top 3 in each event and age category or on a multi-disability basis. The 800m / 1500m events will be swum as open events - there will be no age groups awards for these events.

## **Cameras**

Anyone wishing to use a camera, mobile phone camera, or video camera, should adhere to the Swim England guidelines on the use of images and restrict to their own child and their own private use with no posting on social media or similar platforms. You are reminded that flash photography is not permitted at the start of any heat.

## **Spectators**

There is a maximum number of spectators allowed in the gallery and hence entry may be restricted to comply with this. Spectators will not be permitted to bring their own chairs and must keep all aisles and fire exits clear at all times. Wet swimmers are NOT permitted in the gallery.

## **Data Protection**

Meet entries shall be managed on a computer. Your consent to the holding of personal information for the purposes of the Meet shall be treated as being given by the submission of your entries, as shall your consent for such details to be published during and after the Meet.



## **Disability Swimming**

The conditions for this Meet shall apply to the Disability Swimming events, noting also the following:

- Swimmers with S1 to S15 classifications will be accepted.
- Personal care attendants will only be permitted for swimmers in the following classes: S1, S2, S3, S4, S5 and S11.
- The competition format will be based on disability inclusion within the able-bodied programme. Swimmers will be integrated on a time-banded basis in all events.
- Disability Swimmers will be included in the Multi-Disability results and placed within those results according to the number of British Disability Points gained.
- Where possible an official who holds the qualification of Swim England Disability Official will act as a technical adviser in each of the sessions where disability athletes are entered.
- Medals shall be awarded on a multi-disability basis to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each event.

## **Amendments**

The promoter reserves the right to amend these conditions with the approval of the Swim England South East Licensing Panel. The Promoter, Club and Pool do not accept any liability if part or all of the meet has to be cancelled due to circumstances beyond their control.
